

# Seminole Soil and Water Conservation Board Vacancy

## Seminole County, Florida

**Position:** Supervisor, Seminole Soil and Water Conservation District (SSWCD)

**Application Deadline:** March 18, 2026

**Overview:** The Seminole Soil and Water Conservation Board is seeking a dedicated individual to serve on our Board of Supervisors. This volunteer position plays a vital role in promoting sustainable land use, protecting natural resources, and advancing soil and water conservation efforts in our county.

### Responsibilities:

- Collaborate with the Board and the Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) to develop and implement conservation programs.
- Provide guidance and volunteer time on local soil and water conservation initiatives.
- Engage with agricultural producers, landowners, and community stakeholders to promote sustainable agricultural practices.
- Attend two board meetings (SSWCD) each month on the third Wednesday (a work session and a business meeting) in addition to four meetings each year of local agricultural groups and civic groups, per bylaws.
- Contribute or raise \$300 each year for board programs, per bylaws.
- Conduct yourself as an elected official in Seminole County, Florida.

### Qualifications:

- Must be actively engaged in agriculture (e. g. farming, ranching, or related agricultural activities (Per Florida Statute Chapter 582).
- Passionate about conservation and environmental stewardship.
- Strong communication and collaboration skills.
- Knowledge of local agricultural and environmental challenges preferred.
- Residency in Seminole County, Florida is required.

**Time Commitment:** Two evenings per month, minimum and participation in local board events.
